The Community

The Borough of Metuchen was incorporated in 1900 and is substantially a residential community located in the heart of Middlesex County, one of the fastest growing residential and industrial areas in New Jersey. The Borough is approximately 2.8 square miles in size, and is located 25 miles from New York City. The 2000 population was reported at 12,480. The area is a major employer in pharmaceuticals, health care, financial services, and higher education (Rutgers). Median family income is \$85,022. Population demographics include 83.41% white, 5.30% African American, .10% American Indian, 7.23% Asian, and 3.96% Hispanic or Latino.

Pass/fail and independent study course work is noted on the transcript but is not factored into GPA calculations. All students are ranked at the end of the junior year (6 semesters) and at the end of the senior year (8 semesters). Honors/AP courses carry a + 0.5 differential weighting. AP and Honors courses are noted on the transcript. Individual class rank is not reported on the high school transcript unless specifically requested in writing by student and parent.

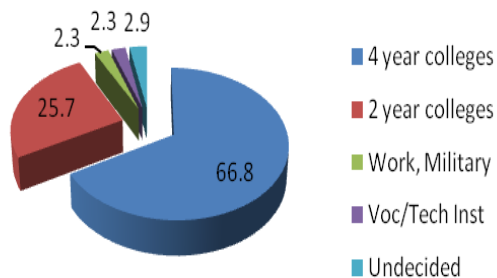
